

# **Medical Scholars in Public Health (MSiPH) Scholarship Policy**

## **Registration for Classes**

Students are encouraged to register for classes early. However, students are required to register for classes prior to the semester's regular registration deadline established by the registrar.

## **Administration of Tuition & Fees**

The tuition and fees support that MSiPH receive will only be applied to COPH Graduate Certificate courses.

MSiPH recipients will receive tuition and fees assistance for no more than 3 consecutive semesters.

Once a MSiPH recipient begins medical school, they will no longer receive financial assistance through this award.

If a MSiPH recipient wishes to pursue a MPH degree, then they must reapply for other scholarships specifically designated for MPH students.

## **Academic Standing**

MSiPH students must maintain a good academic standing to receive the MSiPH scholarship for subsequent semester(s).

Students enrolled in certificate or degree programs in the COPH who earn less than a 3.00 cumulative COPH grade-point average (GPA - rounded to the nearest 1/100th point) on nine (9) or more semester credit hours of course work applicable to their degree program, will be placed on academic probation. (Student Handbook, Academic Probation)

If a student is placed on academic probation, then they will not receive tuition and fees payment for the following semester. The award may be reinstated if the student is removed from academic probation.
